
## From traditional process automation to RPA

RPA increases automation by enabling user automation additionally to existing IT automation levels



- BPM captures detailed business processes (modelling) as flexible and comprehensive platforms above the ERP system and implements workflows (workflow engine).
- RPA concentrates on areas that cannot be automated at BPM or single / ERP system level and can be operated independent of the application.

The RPA tool itself acts like a **human interface** and interacts **directly** with the ERP system by entering transactions, executing programs and extracting reports, optimizing at the lowest level.

A BPM model serves as the basis for the process-oriented implementation of RPA.

Simultaneous use of BPM & RPA is possible to ensure full control over the **entire process**.
